

Mosaic Styles



Roman

Roman style mosaic consists of small pieces of polished marble or glass hand cut into squares and various other shapes used to form the design. Effects of shading and movement can be used to great effect. Classic Roman style mosaic is a perfect match for any interior design.



Florentine

Florentine style mosaics replicate the early Renaissance style of inlay stone design. The individual pieces of polished stone are selected for their unique color and texture and then cut by hand to the different shapes of the design. Florentine style mosaic embodies the elegance of the Renaissance that will enhance any architectural style.



Venetian

Venetian style mosaic consists of larger pieces of stone, cut by hand to the shapes that make up the design, and then treated with an antique patina that mimics centuries-old flooring. Venetian mosaic has a classic Old-World feel, and works especially well in conjunction with Spanish or Italian architecture.
